In the fall of 2021 current students and graduates of the Histotechnology program were surveyed to assess student interest in a BS in Histotechnology. A total of 38 current students responded to the survey. A significant majority of them, 61%, indicated they are very interested in a BS program and are ready to sign up. An additional 24% of current students indiciated they definitely wanted to know more about a potential BS program. A total of 74 Histotechnology graduates responded to the survey. Approximately 80% of graduates indicated that they were either ready to sign up or definitely wanted to learn more. Survey results show that there is signficiant student interested in a possible Histotechnology BS program at Mt. SAC.
