II. New Business

- A. Compensation Requests
 - 1. EOA/SCE (adjuncts) - approved
 - 2. Business (PLO) - approved
- B. Accreditation
 - 1. The process for accreditation will be very different this time
 - 2. Instead of a 600-page report written by one giant team, this will be shorter with multiple small writing teams addressing different areas
 - 3. We will most likely be on several weaving (writing) teams for
 - a. Standard IB: Assuring Academic Quality & Institutional Effectiveness
 - b. Standard IC: Institutional Integrity
 - c. Standard IIA: Instructional Program
 - 4. Expect the first draft to be due by end of April
 - 5. OC members are all invited to be on one of the writing teams
 - 6. Expect more details soon
- C. Competency-Based Education (CBE)
 - 1. POD presentation, Fri 3/18 9-10am, invite other faculty
 - 2. Loni gave a brief presentation highlighting how CBE is different than semester model
 - 3. CBE is an alternative mode of education delivery that is student-centered
 - 4. CBE is beneficial to students who have work experiences but need degree to advance in career
 - 5. CBE can be more equitable than the semester model
 - 6. GE faculty are needed to create curriculum in CBE mode, compensation & training provided

III. Old Business

- A. TiLT Update
 - 1. Prof Eugene Mahmoud (PENG), Prof Stacey Reiseck (Family & Consumer Sciences), and Loni presented TiLT at Team CoCo on Fri, 3/11
 - 2. There were faculty who had done TiLT who encouraged other faculty to join
 - 3. So far, a couple of new faculty have joined
- B. President's Award
 - 1. Application needs to be amended to reflect due date in 2022
 - 2. General campus announcement will go out once Loni changes the application
- C. PLO Liaisons Update
 - 1. GPS has extended the mini-grant funds to allow us to continue this semester
 - 2. 7 of 8 liaisons are returning to continue this work, NSD doesn't have anyone
 - 3. Due to short amount of time, Loni received permission from Chisa (Senate) to ask if any of the 7 liaisons wanted to pick-up the additional 2 LHE to work w/ NSD
 - 4. Nobody wanted the extra work
 - 5. OC supports having Loni serve as liaison for NSD since she is in NSD
 - 6. Loni will get permission from Chisa (Senate)
- D. SLO Student Partnership Project Update
 - 1. Director of Research has approved Annel to work w/ students to survey other students
 - 2. Our student rep, Kelly Kong, and student rep of Accreditation Steering Committee, Matthew Sosa, will be working w/ Annel (RIE) to design surveys on SLO for students
 - 3. Both students have access to Qualtrics and are undergoing training
- E. Technology-NuVentive, Canvas, and Banner Data Pilot
 - 1. PIE has a new update to NuVentive and outcomes has agreed to also update for consistency
 - 2. Several PLO liaisons have reported problems w/ faculty entering in data
 - 3. Kate Morales has corrected the problems
