Coverage is 1985 to present.
- ABI/Inform Global** ⓘ
Consists of nearly 3000 international business periodicals offering in-depth coverage of business and economic conditions, management techniques, theory, and practice of business, advertising, marketing, economics, human resources, finance, taxation, computers, and more. Includes information on 60,000 + companies with business and executive profiles. Includes peer reviewed journals, trade publications, magazines, and newspapers, including The Wall Street Journal.
