Academic Senate	<p>Status of our hard work last year:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. RSI Rubric and Process Recommendation was approved on September 1. The process will now be negotiated. 2. AP 4105 was introduced as a Discussion Item at full Senate on September 1 and will be discussed and voted on in the full Senate meeting of September 15. 3. Roger Willis, our new Academic Senate president, has sent a call to fill the open DLC Committee Member space. 4. Based on the number of DL Forms we will be reviewing this year, and the increased importance of Distance Learning to the campus, it was suggested that DLC increase by an additional two faculty members to handle curriculum and increase representation across divisions. Academic Senate Exec prefers that curriculum review remain a faculty-only process. <p><i>The DLC approves adding committee members to increase representation across campus.</i></p>
