AP score of 3 in Calculus AB-eligible for Math 180; A score 4 or 5 is Mt. SAC's equivalency of Math 180; Calculus BC Math 180 or Math 181 equivalent; Statistics is Math 110 equivalent.

IB score of 5 is Mt. SAC equivalency of Math 180. Submit transcripts to Admissions & Records as soon as possible.


Prerequisite: ENGL 1A or ENGL 1AH

Before attempting to register for a class, check to make sure the class is open (and the wait list is not filled) at the class schedule search page (https://prodss.mtsac.edu/prod/pw_sigsched_p_Search). Mt. SAC's IT Acceptable Use policy (<http://www.mtsac.edu/governance/trustee>) intentionally or negligently performing an act that places an excessive load on a computer or network to the extent that other users may be excessively, repeated unsuccessful registration attempts may result in the placement of a temporary hold on your account.

To add a class, enter the Course Reference Number in the Add Classes section. To drop a class, use the options available in the Action pull-down list.

Without petitioning, students may enroll in up to 18 units each semester and up to 7 units each summer and winter intersession. Students who have completed given semester with a grade point average of at least 3.0 and have a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 may petition for permission to exceed the maximum number of units allowed must contact the Counseling Office (X-4380).


