Mt. San Antonio College is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for its students, employees, and visitors. In light of evidence that the use of tobacco and nicotine, as well as exposure to secondhand smoke and aerosol (commonly referred to as “vapor”) from electronic devices pose significant health and environmental hazards, the College has established a smoke, vapor, and tobacco-free environment.

Smoking of any kind, including use of electronic devices and all uses of tobacco and tobacco products, are prohibited on all property and in all indoor and outdoor spaces owned, leased, licensed, or otherwise controlled by the College, and in all College-owned and leased vehicles.
