

## **Chapter 4 – Academic Affairs**

### **BP 4100 Graduation Requirements for Degrees and Certificates**

#### **References:**

Education Code Section 70902(b)(3); Title 5, Sections 55063, 55060, 55072 et seq., BP 3255

Mt. San Antonio College grants the degrees of Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), and Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT) to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have achieved at least an overall 2.0 grade point average in degree applicable coursework.

Students may be awarded multiple degrees provided that minimum requirements are satisfactorily met for each degree.

For the purposes of meeting degree or certificate requirements, students may elect to meet the requirements of either:

1. The catalog that was in effect at the time they began and maintained continuous enrollment at Mt. San Antonio College; or
2. Any catalog that is or has been in effect during the time that they have maintained continuous enrollment before graduation; or
3. The catalog that is in effect at the time they file an application for a degree or certificate.

The credit residency requirements for Mt. San Antonio College must include a minimum of 12 units completed in residence at Mt. San Antonio College.

Students may be awarded a Certificate of Program Completion upon successful completion of courses of study or curriculum for which Mt. San Antonio College offers a certificate. The College has both credit and noncredit certificate programs.

The College President/CEO in consultation with the Academic Senate shall establish procedures to determine degree and certificate requirements and to assure that graduation requirements are published in the College's catalog(s) and included in other resources that are convenient for students.
