Student Learning Outcomes/General Education

Student learning outcomes (SLOs), like general education outcomes (GEOs), are statements that define specific measurable results expected from students that have undergone a learning experience at Mt. San Antonio College. The difference with GEOs is that determining and assessing GEOs may involve cooperation among multiple disciplines, which reflects the nature of the Mt. SAC general education (GE) pattern.

April 2009 the Academic Senate passed Resolution 2009-02—Transparency of SLOs/GEOs recommending that SLO/GEO data in ePIE be made accessible to all employees through a read-only option by September 2009 in order to share and recognize campus-wide efforts. This new channel is a result of the resolution, and the data is being made available to employees as well as students.
