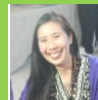

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## Welcome Back

The Welcome Back is a mandatory event that the Arise Program holds usually on the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of Fall and Spring semester, where students are able to meet new and continuing Arise members. This will also give us the opportunity to announce upcoming events we will be hosting for the semester. It is our first "check-in" to help make sure you are staying on track, aware of resources and get answers to questions.

## Fale Fono

The Samoan term "Fale Fono" is translated in English as "community meeting house." At each *Fale Fono*, we use "talk story" (group discussion) and reflective writing to encourage participants to share on various topics throughout the semester. Previous topics include stereotypes of the Pacific Islander student, personal motivation and challenges, strategies to manage obstacles, and working toward personal success. Building on the collective with positive reinforcements, *Fale Fono* is a safe space for vulnerable students to voice their struggles in trying to engage in positive student behaviors, encourages group accountability for meeting academic goals, while helping students motivate each other toward student success.

## Study Hall

*Need some help in Math or Writing?* Then "Study Hall" is for you. We have tutors available during this time in the Arise "Study Hall" area to help students with writing or math. It is open to all Arise students.

## Digital Stories

*Would you like to share your story?* Digital Stories is a year long Arise Program project where students will learn digital tools to share their stories in a fun and intense project building friendships, trust, and purpose as students navigate through their academics and personal lives. 8-10 students will be chosen to complete the project which will begin in December and conclude in June 2020.
