Please note that SIs may not lead class in the professor's absence, record attendance/assignments/exams in grade books, grade assignments/exams in or out of class, or perform clerical duties.

You may refer new SI applicants to obtain an SI Application <u>online</u> or from Tutorial Services. SI candidates must meet the following criteria:

- A minimum 3.0 Overall GPA
- Completion of the course for which they are applying with a grade of A or B
- Good oral and written communication skills
- Additional qualifications as listed on SI Application
