This ADT, the Associate in Science in Nutrition and Dietetics for Transfer, introduces students to the principles and methodologies used in the study of nutrition and dietetics, and allows students to acquire the foundational knowledge necessary to pursue post-secondary degrees in nutrition and dietetics. This program will allow nutrition and dietetics students to earn an Associate Degree in their major prior to transfer. Additionally, this program will help Mt.
