Eligibility:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This Scholarship is awarded to current forensics team competitors who have successfully completed two semesters of forensics by the end of Fall 2014. Students must submit unofficial transcripts to confirm forensics units.• Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.7 and be in good standing with the College.
Application Process:	Students must submit the attached application and supplemental materials (see below) to Roger Willis' mailbox in the Department of Communication Office (Building 26D) no later than 12:30 on Tuesday, November 18.

Awards:	Award recipients and scholarship amounts will vary. Students may apply awards toward academic or Forensics expenses for Spring 2015.
Notification:	Award winners will be announced Thursday, December 4, 2014 at the Fall "Speak O'Rama."
