Blackboard Update	Kerry reported that Blackboard is continuing to work on a solution to the Snapshot problem as it still isn't working properly. Blackboard has placed the problem as its highest priority.	Kerry will send an e-mail to the Deans today to apprise them of the situation.	
	Kerry gave kudos to Dwight for his good job communicating with faculty and his diligent work with Blackboard and IT. Shanti confirmed that the Help Desk has been forwarding information to Dwight for the students who are having Blackboard issues. In return, Dwight has provided the Help Desk with some additional information to provide to the students.	The Help Desk will continue to forward the calls to Dwight. If any faculty members have technical issues, they should notify Dwight immediately. Urgent e-mail notices to faculty should be flagged as being important.	
Tutorial Services Update	Meghan stated one of the outcomes from the Fall semester faculty focus group was the support for online tutoring. To accomplish online tutoring, she noted four issues that need to be addressed: 1) the need for Tutorial Services funding for enough staff to designate as online tutors; 2) pedagogy and training; 3) how to deliver the service online; and 4) how to comply with regulations. Terri suggested Blackboard training for tutors and noted there are many different levels in Blackboard that could work for tutors.	Meghan will arrange a meeting with Terri and Mary and some tutors to explore the issue in more depth.
