DL Strategic Plan	After the DL Strategic Plan was presented and discussed at the Curriculum and Instruction Council meeting, it was decided that information in the plan would be reported to the campus in another format.	In lieu of the DL Strategic Plan being presented at Academic Senate as a plan, it will instead be presented as a DL Report. Additionally, an e-PIE for the DL program will be completed for 2008-09.
DL Committee Goals 2008-2009	The College has adopted new campus-wide goals for 2008-2009. College committees have been asked to identify three to five goals to work on this year, link them to the College goals, and submit them to PAC by November 14, 2008.	 DLC identified five goals: Goal 1 (Linked to College goals 1, 4, 5, 7): Study the ways in which the College can comply with the new federal mandate for colleges offering distance learning courses to authenticate all students; make recommendations to C&I for proposed policy or resolutions. Goal 2 (Linked to College goals 1, 5, 9, 11): Utilize more of the Blackboard Enterprise system (Learning system + Content system + Community system) and Luminis to provide more services and capabilities for students and faculty. Goal 3 (Linked to College goals 2, 5, 6, 7): Collect data and courses currently not offered in DL format; review that data vis-a-vis course offerings across the curriculum to enable students to complete a degree or general education through distance learning courses. Goal 4 (Linked to College goals 1, 2, 5, 6, 8): Commission studies on student success and retention in DL courses and to make recommendations to C&I for new policy (policies) or resolution(s).

		Goal 5 (Linked to College goals 1, 5, 8, 11): Inform administrators on DL course development/approval, faculty evaluation process for DL courses, faculty certification process, best practices in teaching DL courses, and issues facing distance learning.
