 - ✓ Be in good standing with the EOPS/CARE Program and Mt. SAC.
 - ✓ Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (preferred).
 - ✓ Must have completed at least 12 units at Mt. SAC.
 - ✓ Must be available to work at least 15 hours per week.
 - ✓ Must be enrolled in at least 6 units during the Spring 2021 semester.
 - ✓ Must be able to attend required training meetings on last Fridays of every month (10:00 am 12:00 pm)

 - ✓ Submit a complete application form.
 - ✓ Provide 2 professional references.
 - ✓ Submit Resume.
