EOPS Counseling Requirements:

However, keep in mind that contacts should be spaced out by a minimum of two weeks. This means that you cannot complete all our contacts in one month.

ON 2/1. If you add classes after, we will not be able to adjust your grant amount since grants are released a week before school starts.
