

To review your financial aid information, follow the steps below:

New Students

1. You must claim and activate your online student portal account using the Username assigned to you in your welcome letter. To claim your account, visit <https://inside.mtsac.edu> and click on “**1st Time Users (Claim Account)**”.
2. Once you have claimed your Mt. SAC account and logged into the Mt. SAC Portal, you may view your financial aid status.

New and Continuing Students

1. Log into your Mt. SAC account at <https://inside.mtsac.edu>.
2. Click on the “**Financial Aid**” link to check your financial aid status.

Viewing your Financial Aid Status

After clicking on “**Look Up Financial Aid Status**”, you will have access to view detailed information regarding the status of your financial aid.

1. Select the “**Aid Year**” (the academic year for which you are receiving financial aid), and click “**Submit**”.

To view Satisfied/Unsatisfied Student Requirements

1. Click on the “**student requirements**” link.

You have unsatisfied **student requirements** for this aid year.

2. **Unsatisfied requirements** are documents needed to complete your file. Promptly submit required documents in the drop box located next to counter number 1 (one) of the Financial Aid Office.

To view Financial Aid Award status

1. Click on the “**awarded**” link.

2. Click on the “**Award Overview**” tab to see all awards currently in your financial aid package.

NOTE: The Board of Governors Fee Waiver is awarded to eligible students as soon as the FAFSA is received. Eligibility for additional aid is determined when all outstanding requirements are completed.

To view Academic Progress status

1. Click on the “**academic progress**” link.

Based on your **academic transcript**, the status of your **academic progress**

2. If you have **unsatisfactory academic progress** that suspends your financial aid, you may submit a Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) appeal to the Financial Aid Office.

Check your Financial Aid link in your Mt. SAC Portal and Mt. SAC Student email account regularly for information regarding your financial aid status.
