





Senior Attendance





Attendance by Race/Ethnicity



SOURCE OF DATA

Each year California Cash for College collects participant exit surveys at the time of the workshop. How Did We Do summaries aggregate distinct participant exit surveys to create online reports. Participant FAFSA, California Dream Act Application and Cal Grant Application data was extracted from the California Student Aid Commission Grant Delivery System (GDS) in late August 2015

FAFSA/Dream Act Applications

The Free application of Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the CA Dream Act application are gateway applications for grant financial aid in California. Application counts are grouped together.

Submitted/Completed FAFSAs & CA Dream Act Applications

Submitted: Aggregate count of FAFSAs & CA Dream Act Applications submitted by workshop, organization, county, region or state levels. Percentage is based on FAFSA/Dream act applications submitted from all Cash for College participants.

Completed: Aggregate count of FAFSAs & CA Dream Act Applications submitted and that can be processed for financial aid. This means applications that have generated an Expected Family Contribution (EFC). Percentage is based on FAFSA/Dream act applications that have EFC, which means they can be processed for financial aid considerations.

Estimated Pell Grants: The federal government states Pell eligibility for each completed FAFSA. Using Pell eligibility for each qualifying applicant and the most recently available average Pell Grant award of \$3,650, estimated Pell grant funding is displayed.

Cal Grant Applications

Submitted: Number of students who submitted a FAFSA & CA Dream Act Application and a Cal Grant GPA. Percentage is based on Cal Grant applications submitted from all workshop participants.

Completed: Students who submitted a complete FAFSA or Dream Act Application (one that has an EFC) and Cal Grant GPA by March 2 deadline. Percentage is based on Cal Grant Applications that were complete and received by the deadline.

Offered: Number and percentage of applicants who were offered a Cal Grant Award.

Cal Grant Funding Offered: Using commission Cal Grant Award offers amounts, aggregated dollar amounts are displayed.
