STEPS TO APPLY



- Submit a Mt. SAC Admission Application for Summer term at www.mtsac.edu**
Click on "Apply Now" and complete a summer term application.
- Activate your Mt. SAC Student Portal account**
After you apply you will receive an email with instructions on how to claim and activate your online Mt. SAC student portal account. Go to inside.mtsac.edu and type in the username assigned to you by Mt. SAC. For step-by-step instructions on how to claim your student account go to the [Summer Bridge website](#)
- Submit a Summer Bridge Application**
Log in to your Mt. SAC student account to access the electronic application. Step-by-step instructions are available on the [Summer Bridge website](#)
- Complete the Assessment Questionnaire (AQ)**
Complete the AQ at www.mtsac.edu/aq or on your student portal under the Student Success tab. The AQ determines what English and Math courses you should take at Mt. SAC. You will need your Mt. SAC username and password to complete the AQ.
- Apply for Financial Aid**
Submit your financial aid applications for both 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 school years by March 2, 2021. The FAFSA and Dream Act applications are available online. Mt. SAC's Federal School Code is 001245.

 - 2021-2022 is required for the 2021-2022 school year

SUMMER BRIDGE

The Summer Bridge Program is the perfect way for graduating high school students to begin their college journey and transition to college. This six week program is ideal for low income, first generation students who would benefit from additional support through their first year of college. Students build connections with campus resources and staff, teachers, counselors, and peer mentors.

Students take introduction to college courses that prepare them for the expectations of college. Students will learn study skills, learn how to prepare for the fall semester, and explore major and career options. Summer Bridge students receive priority registration for the Fall semester and priority into the Fall Bridge Program, and may qualify for Mt. SAC's Promise +Plus benefits.

FALL AND SPRING LEARNING COMMUNITIES

Fall and Spring Bridge is an ideal program for new and continuing college students. Math and English classes, paired with a Counseling class are offered to provide students a structured, unique learning experience. Students work in teams, and receive academic and personal support and peer mentoring. Students will learn what it takes to succeed in college and beyond.

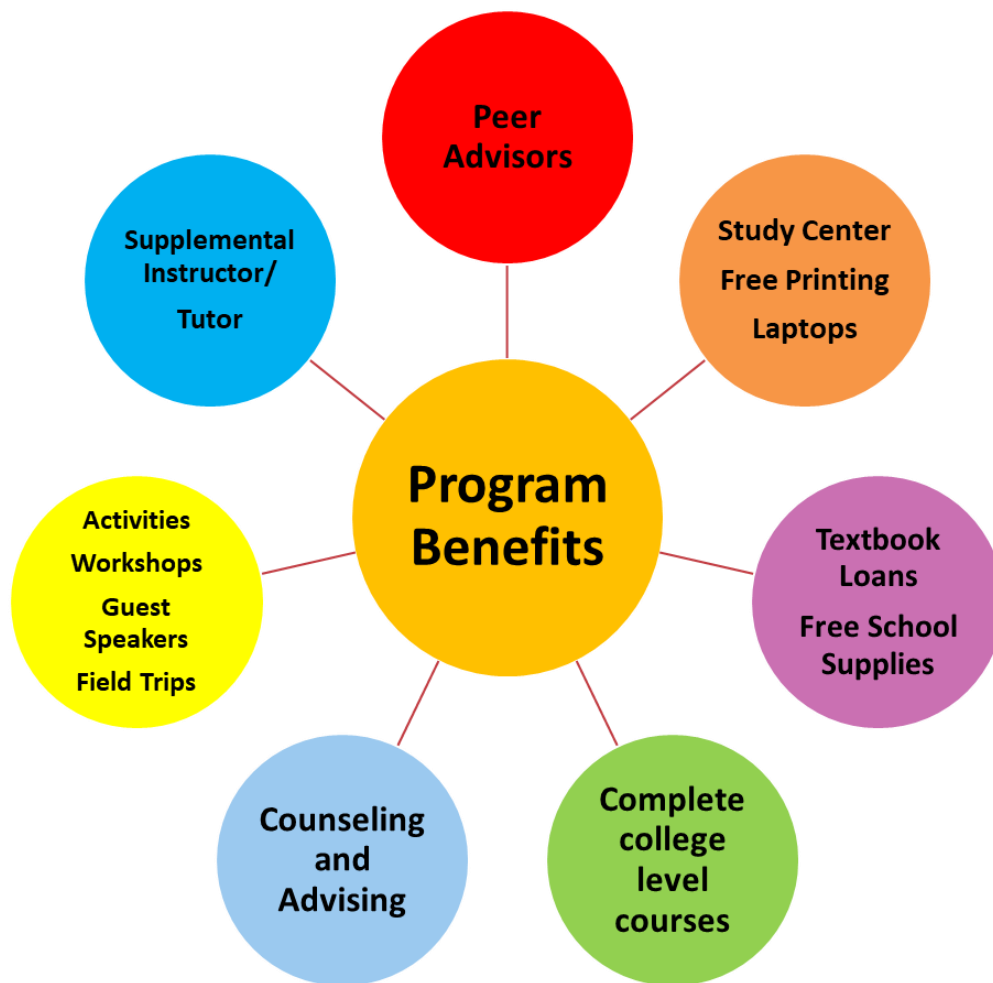


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
