Get Admitted To Honors

Applying to the Honors Program is easy! Go to honors.mtsac.edu and click on the link to apply online.

Have 9 or more transferable college units completed? You are a **COLLEGE APPLICANT!** To apply as a college applicant, you must:

- Be English 1A eligible
- Have earned a minimum 3.2 transferable GPA
- Have completed 9 transferable units
- Submit along with your application:
 - Maximum 350-word essay (see application for prompts)
 - Letter of Recommendation (Letter waived if cumulative GPA is 3.5 or better)*

Are you a graduating high school student or have less than 9 transferable college units completed? You are a **HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANT.** To apply as a high school applicant, you must:

- Be English 1A eligible
- Have earned a minimum 3.2 unweighted GPA
- Submit along with your application:
 - Unofficial high school transcripts
 - Maximum 350-word essay (see application for prompts)
 - Letter of Recommendation*
 - AP/IB Scores (if applicable)

*NOTE: Letter of recommendation should be from a teacher or counselor commenting on your character, scholarly commitment, and academic strengths.

For priority consideration, apply by the following deadlines:

Last Monday in June for **FALL** semester

Last Monday in October for **WINTER** Intersession

First Monday in January for **SPRING** semester

Last Monday in April for **SUMMER** Intersession
