

## **STUDENT PREPARATION AND SUCCESS COUNCIL**

### Purpose

The Student Preparation and Success Council exists to make recommendations regarding student preparation and success based on stakeholder input and informed discussion.

### Function

1. Research, review, develop, and recommend to the Academic Senate policies and procedures related to student preparation and success.
2. Analyze and synthesize data and information to develop recommendations on policies to provide input to the campus decision-making process. (Reference Title 5, section 53200 – that “standards or policies regarding student preparation and success” are “academic and professional matters.”)
3. Refer issues and concerns to subcommittees for follow-up.
4. Review recommendations from the Student Success and Support Program Advisory, Student Equity, and Basic Skills committees and provide direction as needed.
