III. Updates (30 minutes)

- Basic Needs Resources (Rigo):
 - o CalFresh Outreach (regular updates Rigo/Brenda): CalFresh is moving smoothly, encouraging students to apply. In the month of October have had 30 applications submitted, as of today. Improved engagement with county liaisons with San Bernardino County in getting advocacy and support. Received our renewal. We get a portion of funds from the Feds for time and effort. First 3 years of our contract we received 64k a year that supported our CFO team and supplies and events. We have bumped up to 80k for CFO efforts.
 - Mountie Fresh Food Pantry (Rigo): 780 students in September attend. During the first week of October had 580 students attend. Students are experiencing the pantry smoothly from checkin, time in store to checkout. In-Reach ambassadors will be assisting with checkout and providing information to students.
 - o Housing (Rigo): Jovens has secured 2 apartment units. Will place 2 males in one apartment.
 - Case management (Rigo): Two social workers have been working and all is going well.
 - Basic Needs Resources Allyship Project (Rigo): this is an initiative similar to Dream program and Pride Center that addresses basic needs. Allows staff and faculty to feel more confident and comfortable talking to students about Basic Needs. First cohort, goal is to have this ready by December, but does not want to call it a training, this will be a hybrid model, will work with BNC to help committee members to become allies. This will include receiving swag and a logo to add to your signature. No other colleges are doing this. Long Beach State has an aggressive ideal to have a national model for an allyship. Director, Basic Needs Resources position (Koji): this position has officially been posted online.
 We are one of the few colleges that is offering this position, but as time passes and basic needs increase, we will see more colleges have these kinds of positions.

 students needs differ so it would be hard to personalize these bags. We could pinpoint items that
 students need and want, which would be more beneficial. Knowing the quantity of items is
 important due to storage space limits in the pantry. Rigo also mentioned this professor contacted
 him about having her students volunteer at our food pantry.
- Finish Purpose, Function, and Goals: reviewed goal #6. Discussed the importance of keeping this goal, especially with accreditation approaching.
