3.	Report from IEC Representative	No report was presented, as the IEC concluded its meetings last month and will reconvene in the fall.			
4.	2025-26 Tentative Budget Update	Rosa Royce presented the 2025-26 Tentative Budget. The following are key takeaways (reports attached): FY 24-25 is now projected to close with a \$7.3 M surplus and a healthy 21.5 % reserve. FY 25-26 shows a structural deficit of \$4.6 M driven by compensation and benefit pressures; gap rises to \$7.6 M after one-time items. Even after using reserves to balance 2025-26, ending fund balance remains almost double the 10 % Board-policy floor, but the trend is downward.
