Function:

1. To track the creation of new computation, reading, and composition requisites and advisories.
2. To disseminate information regarding accessing, interpreting, and using success and retention data so as to clarify where placing or altering computation, reading, and composition requisites might improve student success or create disproportionate impacts.
3. To notify the District and affected departments of the impact of new computation, reading, and composition requisites on course offerings and student success.
4. To review content review processes and recommend implementation to the Academic Senate via the Curriculum & Instruction Council.
