Information Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC) Report (Rich)	<p>Meeting date: April 2, 2018</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minutes were reviewed and approved Instruction VP, Irene Malmgren reported that the Accreditation Steering Committee is implementing a process to identify committees on campus that are doing work related to certain accreditation themes. The purpose is to much earlier identify and document those actions being taken related to accreditation themes, so the bulk of the investigation and work is not done at the last minute in preparing for an accreditation visit. Director Infrastructure & Data Security, Christopher Schroeder updated ITAC with the progress his committee has been making on the Security Policies for the college. Director of Information Technology, Dale Vickers gave ITAC an update on the work he and his staff have been making on the coordination of the Technology Master Plan (TMP) with the overall Facilities and Educational Master Plan (FEMP). He asked everyone in ITAC to submit input to the TMP as it relates to their respective constituent (faculty, staff, administration, etc).
