A bachelor's degree in a biological science and the unit/course equivalent to a master's degree in the discipline or a related discipline and significant progress towards a Ph.D. degree in a biological science such as, but not limited to: Anatomy, Physiology, Animal Physiology, Biochemistry, Biomedical Sciences, Biophysics, Biotechnology, Marine Biology, Microbiology, Immunology, Cell or Molecular Biology, Genetics, Histology, Embryology/ Developmental Biology, Botany, Plant Sciences, Biology Education, Ecology/ Environmental Biology, Evolutionary Biology, Entomology, Zoology, Herpetology, Ornithology, Ichthyology, Mammology, or Paleobiology/Paleobotany/Paleozoology. "Significant progress" shall be defined as having advanced to candidacy for the degree as designated on the candidate's transcript or documented by a written statement from an authorized representative of the institution which will award the degree;

OR

A bachelor's degree in a biological science **and** an advanced degree in the biomedical sciences, such as M.P.H., M.P.S.H., M.D., D.O., D.D.S., D.M.D., or D.V.M.

Rationale:

- 1. Allows for Ph.D. candidates whose educational background is equivalent to a master's degree, but have not completed their Ph.D., to be considered for hiring.
- 2. The bachelor's degree in a biological science provides breadth in biology that the biomedical graduate degrees lack, while the biomedical graduate degrees listed provide depth.
