1.0	Review Agenda/Minutes	The committee reviewed the minutes from May 11, 2015 and suggested a minor change.	Minutes approved		
2.0	2015-16 Student Equity Plan Template	Audrey Yamagata-Noji, VPSS explained the 2015-16 Student Equity Plan Template. She provided a comparison chart which shows SSSP & SEP changes from the previous year's requirements. She shared that while the committee must oversee the process, a core writing team will start the process and come back to the committee for approval. The core team will consist of Liza Becker, Don Sciore, Marcell Gilmore, Jeff Archibald and Audrey Yamagata-Noji.	The committee was made aware of the core writing team and the committee's responsibilities as well as the complexities of the 2015-16 Student Equity Plan.		
		The new plan also requires community input. Discussion regarding the appointment of a community member to the committee could present a challenge to the total composition because faculty must be the majority. 3.0	2015-16 Student Equity Plan Submission Calendar	The committee discussed the timeline necessary to ensure that the College satisfies the Student Equity Plan submission date.	The calendar was developed with the timelines to submit the Student Equity Plan to the Chancellor's Office by the December 18th, deadline. The calendar includes the dates to ensure approval through the governance process with final approval by the Board of Trustees.
4.0	Chancellor's Office Feedback from 2014-15 Student Equity Plan	The committee reviewed the feedback from last year's plan. The document offers some guidance regarding the successful submission of the plan and maybe helpful for the 2015-16 plan.	Based on the feedback from the Chancellor's Office the Mt. SAC Student Equity Plan satisfied all of the required elements, except for two areas; one related to target population, i.e., "some other race' and "more than one race." The other related to demonstrated links between goals, activities and budget.
5.0	Research	John Barkman reported on research for the 2015-16 Student Equity Plan. He noted that this Plan allows for a new measurement of disproportionality called "Percentage Gap Points." One favorable aspect of this new measurement is that the actual number of targeted students who need intervention can be determined in order to eliminate the disproportionality.	The Research Team will continue to provide data to determine the disproportionate impact among the target groups and the committee will decide if the measurements are significantly disproportionate or not.
