2.0	Equity Reading Club: Elevating Equity for Social Mobility	The committee members read a paper from the Community College League of California titled "Elevating Equity for Social Mobility". SAC; (3) It was reported that back in 1992 Mt. SAC was fortunate to establish the Student Equity Program; (4) It was noted that race is a difficult discussion.  Committee members all agreed to continue discussing student's first generation who are tied to the Student Equity Programs or projects to consider.
