It's pending board approval on December 13, 2017. Via email, Barbara McNeice-Stallard had an inquiry regarding section #9 "2017-2018 Annual Allocation amount" and Eric explained Fiscal only approved 80% allocation and the other 20% is pending approval. Eric also reported per Chancellor's office all three programs will receive 'block funding' and Mt. SAC doesn't see this as a problem moving forward. The committee members discussed both the article and audio feedback. Committee members shared their personal experience with their professors; the negative comments and feedback, the micro aggressions; instructor expectations from students; students are marginalized; received messages about their inferiority and inability based on their race, ethnicity, citizenship status, gender, and sexuality; not getting validation of students' effort and ability.
