3.0	Student Equity Research Action Plan: Jaime and John	Jaime Rodriguez and John Barkman provided the committee members the first draft of Student Equity Research Action Plan. During a one-on-one meeting with Eric Lara and Barbara McNeice-Stallard, the idea for an action plan was discussed and the purpose would be to use as a guide when collecting data and research for all Student Equity programs. In addition, it will increase the effectiveness of campus efforts and will address closing performance gaps. The committee members reviewed the first draft, provided feedback, and suggested updates. Recommendations (1) to collect demographic data alongside examples of events; (2) anecdotal vs telling students their stories; and (3) use the table for classroom reporting and keeping it confidential.	The committee members approved the Student Equity Research Action Plan updates and corrections; next is to present the revised version during the 11/25/2019 SEC meeting to be reviewed and approved then move forward to shared governance committees.
