The committee determined that while this individual does clearly possess a Bachelor's degree in Ethnic Studies, the minimum qualifications require a Master's degree. This candidate's Master's degree does not meet minimum qualifications. The committee would like to confer that this candidate meets the minimum qualifications in Art History and also meets equivalency in Humanities.

 - Comparative Literature, History, Art History, Interdisciplinary Studies, Speculative Fiction, Film Theory, Philosophy, Religious Studies, Gender Studies, and Cultural Studies.
 - The discipline expert provides examples of Humanities courses from accredited institutions that include coursework in all of the above listed disciplines.
 - Candidates did not request equivalency because of the understanding that general Humanities courses will include coursework in all of the above disciplines.
