 - PSOMAS was awarded the Request for Proposal (RFP) work for the Environmental Impact Services (EIR) for the Parking & Circulation Master Plan (PCMP). Their master contract will be presented at the June 28th Board Meeting. Their scope of work includes parking, traffic, and transit CEQA/NEPA related efforts.

2. PROJECT BUDGET REPORT MAY 2017

- B. <u>Business & Computer Technology</u>: The project is tracking well at 75% completion. Installations of audio visual equipment, furniture, and ceiling projectors is currently underway. Occupancy is anticipated to be January of 2018.
- C. <u>West Parcel Solar</u>: Based on the legal hearing it was ruled that additional project specific CEQA analysis is required, additional studies are currently underway.
- D. Athletics Complex East Phase I: Demolition and abatement of the area adjacent to the project continues.
- E. <u>Transit Center:</u> The project design from Foothill Transit is about 20% complete. PSOMAS will be providing the CEQA/NEPA environmental project support.
