- C. Mika proposed the addition of Steve Williams, ABE adjunct faculty who teaches vocational agriculture, as a permanent member of the task force.
 - The group agreed to the proposed addition.

4. RFP FOR CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES UPDATE (IIIB)

- A. Gary gave an update on the RFP for Construction Inspection Services.
 - Two firms will be recommended to CMPCT.

5. PLANNING UPDATES/PRESENTATIONS (IIIB)

- A. John Gaston presented the Temple Avenue Green Corridor Project through the *Temple Avenue Green Corridor Project Conceptual Review* PowerPoint.
 - The presentation reviewed:
 - The 2018 EFMP Open Space Concept
 - o A conceptual project overview including interactions with the:
 - Wildlife Sanctuary
 - Athletic Fields (soccer and baseball)
 - Parking Structure S
 - Athletics Neighborhood
 - o Trees and Planting
 - Fencing
 - John plans to return in December to present a more detailed plan of the south side of Temple Avenue and finalized recommendations regarding sidewalk design (potentially meandering), tree spacing and locations, and the new fencing standard.
- B. Maritza Penaloza and Mika presented the Lot H Northeast Classroom Village through the Lot H/Northeast Classroom Village Facilities Advisory Committee PowerPoint dated October 14, 2019.
 - The presentation reviewed:

 - This project replaces the 21-series modulars, the 30-series modulars, and the Adult Basic Education Center (Building 30).
 - The 2018 EFMP and proposed location of the new SCE and AE facilities

 - Lot H NE Classroom Village Pedestrian Walks and Healthy Living Loop
 - Lot H NE Classroom Village Proposed Site Plan
 - The project scope also includes new faculty offices and new SCE Sim and Computer Labs.

- C. Mika presented the Bookstore/Instruction project through the Bookstore/Instruction Building Update Facilities Advisory Committee PowerPoint dated October 14, 2019.
