It's a significant decrease from what we've received previously.</li> <li>We have to pay LHE for faculty (co-coordinators and mapping coordinator)</li> <li>We have \$476,000 left to spend on projects or \$159k per year if we spread out over 3 years. Funds must be spent by June 30, 2026.</li> <li>Discussed the current goals and how vague they are. <ul> <li>Current and new projects should be aligned with the goals.</li> <li>We need to be intentional with remaining money.</li> </ul> </li> <li>R. Willis stated that he will report back and see what he is able to find out.</li> <li>Discussed inviting R. Brown (Work Experience) to a future meeting.</li> <li>M. Nava to put the rubric on one drive and distribute. Please review prior to next meeting.</li> <li>Cap to be placed on the projects to ensure equitable distribution.</li> </ul>
