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Summary of Notable Achievements: • Substantial changes to curriculum and instruction, including: new course offerings to support more specialized fields in the drone and photography industries such as Social Media Marketing and Thermal Imaging, prerequisite and certificate changes to support a better guided pathway, and hiring of a new full-time faculty growth position

• Two Photography students were accepted to ArtCenter and a Drone student jobbed out into the industry, while we continue to work on work experience, oncampus collaborations, and internship opportunities for students.

• New equipment purchased this year was put directly into student's hands and saw results immediately. Full frame Canon systems, new Macbook Pros, DJI Matrice drone, new LED lighting systems and more.

Program Planning (Equity, Retention and Success): • Obviously, there has been much discussion regarding adapting to Covid19. All Photography classes were moved online while the Drone courses had been canceled.

• For the upcoming year, the Program is adapting and adjusting to student class preferences. Course offerings have been adjusted to better suit student schedules and even a Drone course will be adapted to be taught online.

• Purchasing has similarly been adjusted to support online student's goals and to aid instructors in conveying information traditionally taught in the studio. Faculty and staff are still working on how to maintain contact with students who are near to completing their educational goals and ensuring they complete the required paperwork.

External and Internal Conditions Analysis: • Covid19 will have a lasting impact on our Program, as we cannot teach students in the traditional manner.

• Additionally, the anticipated CA fiscal restrictions will force us to purchase with great caution.

• Internally, we are happy to have faculty and staff that are willing to adjust and work in the ever-changing environment we now find ourselves in. While one fulltime faculty member did retire, the addition of another will help spread the workload.

Critical Decisions Made by Unit: • Curriculum: Adjustments to Photography and Drone curriculum were deemed necessary once we saw students register for classes that they were unprepared for, or were unable to sign up for the beginning Drone class because of it's prerequisite.

• Student Assistants: Requested Perkins funds for Drone student assistants separately from Photography student assistants. Students enrolled in the Drone classes benefit greatly from their instructor having additional support during lab time, both on campus and on location.

• Pathways and Certificates: Will pursue the creation of a Commercial Video pathway or certificate to address the specialty in the industry. Will continue to improve the Photography Video Production Certificate with the addition of a Director of Photography course in conjunction with the Film & Television program. Will continue to work with the Aeronautics Department in pursuit of a FAA Authorization.

| | Our state of the art program is growing, with successful increased course offerings every year. We have recently hired one full-time and several adjunct faculty but we are still in need of more instructors. We currently have three full-time faculty and 13 adjunct instructors. We believe the following data clearly supports the need for another full- time Photography Professor. | |

In 2016 (calendar year) we filled 57 sections (225 LHE) with 142.75 LHE taught by adjuncts and 22.75 LHE full-time faculty overload. In 2018, we filled 74 sections (274.75 LHE) with 127.75 taught by adjuncts and 57 LHE full-time faculty overload. In other words, from 2016-2018 our program increased by 49.25 LHE's (22%) and 17 sections (30%). Therefore, in addition to 45 LHE base load for our three full-time faculty, in 2018 there were 57 LHE (overload) plus 127.75 LHE (part-time) for a total of 184.75 LHE remaining to support additional full-time faculty members. These numbers do not reflect PHOT 98, PHOT 99, or Dept. Chair reassigned time. We are growing steadily every year and we have ample LHE's to support another full-time professor in the Photography Program. It should be noted that our growth is particularly impressive at a time when the other photography programs in our area are struggling with shinking enrollment and class cancellations.

As a CTE program, in addition to instruction, our three full-time faculty members have numerous other program management responsibilities (Advisory Committee, Outreach/In-Reach, high school articulation, scheduling, Perkins, SWP, budget, hiring and oversight of adjunct faculty, student

workers and lab staff, PIE, Outcomes, supervising students in on-campus and off-campus work experience, program marketing, connecting students to industry, advising students for transfer and workforce entry, equipment and facilities oversight, student club advising, assisting students with course selection and educational planning, and more.). A recent poll indicates that full-time faculty in our department (CEA) work an average of 400+ hours/yearly on program management. This means that each of our current full-time faculty members work in excess of 200 hours (each) over the contracted 192 service hours. This indicates that there is a large deficit of personhours for program management activities, some of which could be fulfilled by an additional full-time faculty member. Due to rapidly changing technology, photography faculty also spend a considerable amount of time attending conferences and workshops, networking, and researching emerging technologies and industry trends and writing new curriculum for classroom integration.

The new faculty member will need a diverse set of skills to support the broad range of curriculum we currently offer which includes: analog, digital still and motion capture, digital editing workflow and output, studio and location lighting,

fashion and commercial portraiture, wedding and family portraiture, advertising, historic and alternative processes, and studio business practices. In addition to program growth in our existing program, the photography program is also expanding into new areas: we have responded to the "convergence" of still and motion technologies with PHOT 26 Video for Photographers, and the Photography Video Production Certificate. We plan to update this curriculum with the addition of a new Director of Photography course (in collaboration with our Film/Television Program). We are also on the forefront of new emerging technologies with two new programs: Drones and 360VR Imaging. The new drone curriculum consists of four new courses, two certificates and one A.S degree and the 360 VR curriculum has four new courses and a new certificate. These new programs are funded by the Strong Workforce Program and are supported by recent surveys indicating high student interest and very strong labor market data. To meet our SWP performance benchmarks, fulfill our commitment to the grant, and to support student demand, we expect the new programs will require a significant increase in course offerings (LHE). We do not have enough faculty with the necessary skills to teach all our existing courses plus the new curriculum, and it is crucial that we
