### Where We Are: Analysis and Summary

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**External Conditions, Trends, or Impacts (Student Services):** Inflationary increases: supplies and equipment costs continue to increase without corresponding increases. With new buildings come new landscaping and hardscape areas requiring a higher level of maintenance than the areas they replaced. They also require more replacement irrigation parts, mulch, and plant material as they age.

Increase in areas to maintain, due to new buildings and new landscaping, will require additional staffing.

The tall, large, and aging trees/palms require trimming and removal services, which is an increase in expenses that are our of our control.

Although Phase I of our \$300.000.00 Maxicom irrigation system 16/17 project is complete, funding resources are a continued need.

Internal Conditions, Trends, or Impacts (Student Services): Increased events: The number and size of events continue to on campus as well as on the sports fields, placing additional demands on the staff. This also causes wear and tear on campus and the sports fields, which in turn, deplete supplies.

Increase maintenance requirements: We continue to employ hourly workers from our small pool of grounds workers.

Increased campus population: Increased students, staff, and public use of the facilities has resulted in an increased need for additional staff and supplies.

Need of a \$70,000.00 budget line item: We are currently paying our hourly employee budget out of the salary savings and our one-time funding account, which will go away when we get fully staffed.

One-time funds have not been granted to buy and replace tools, small engine equipment and supply the crew with safety gear. ??????
