








# SISC: How to Search for Providers in your Network

## How to Find a Blue Shield Provider

1. Login into the health plan website [https://blueshieldca21-prod.modolabs.net/find\\_provider/](https://blueshieldca21-prod.modolabs.net/find_provider/)
2. Select “**Providers within California**’ from the plan type you are searching.
3. Choose what **type of care** you are looking for.
4. Input your locations or area (city, state or zip) and click **SEARCH**
5. Search by **DOCTOR TYPE** or **DOCTOR NAME** and click on the blue **SEARCH** button once you have entered your specific search criteria.
6. A query list based on your search will display.








