Chancellor's Office Announcement: Gemini Al	On September 10, the Chancellor's Office and Google announced a system-wide partnership to provide AI tools, training, and certification to students, faculty, and staff. The College has a Google tenant for students. For many years, the tenant was allowed unlimited storage space, but that changed a couple of years ago. IT did extensive work to modify the student tenant to meet the space limitations and has successfully stayed under the cap.	Discussion will continue at future ITAC meetings.
	The College has the free version of Co-Pilot for staff and faculty because they are in the Microsoft tenant. Michael shared that the full version of Co-Pilot is \$320 per year per user, and the College doesn't have this version to distribute.	
	Dominick indicated that some faculty prefer the Google web-based platform for ease of use on a Mac and with Linux. There are issues with intellectual property rights and the AI services.	
	Amelia shared that she is a member of the Educational Technology Committee that is working on a general Al policy and a more

	specific policy for students and faculty. She also discussed privacy concerns with Canvas and indicated that Canvas's HECVAT responses indicate some security issues. She would like to know if ITAC or the Educational Technology committee will address the protection and usage of student data. Chris shared the Higher Education Community Vendor Assessment Toolkit (HECVAT) process that assists the College in assessing data security, privacy, and compliance risks before purchasing or renewing software or cloud services. It also ensures vendors meet FERPA, GLBA, CPRA, and other regulatory requirements. Some vendors score better than others on the HECVAT tool, and not all vendors provide a HECVAT.	
Academic Technology Update	Michael reported that the Team is moving forward with the Computer Replacement Program installations for Fall 2025 for faculty and staff computers that are identified as five years or older. Michael shared the Student Tech website and the technology resources that are available to students. Pedro shared that there is a feedback form at the bottom of the site, and IT has made changes to the website based on student recommendations.
