Demo: Pilot of New Class Schedule Search	<p>Antonio Bangloy, Director of Enterprise Application Systems, and Loralyn Isomura, Instructional Services Analyst, joined the meeting to demonstrate the new class schedule search. Antonio shared that this is phase 1 of the redesign of the class schedule search based on feedback from students, faculty, and the campus community. It is currently in a test system, and IT's goal is to move it to production by the end of March.</p> <p>Loralyn showed the design of the new search page. She showed how to search by term, course attributes, and other search fields. She shared some features of the search page, such as bookmarking and the interactive torch icon.</p> <p>The Committee asked some questions and indicated that the new design and functionality are a significant improvement from the current Banner 9 schedule search.</p>	Information only.

	<p>transitioning them to the Windows 11 operating system as part of the refresh cycle.</p> <p>Michael noted that the cost of computers has been increasing rapidly in recent months. For example, the cost of a standard computer increased from approximately \$1,400 in January to about \$1,900 in February. He explained that the price increase is largely due to global memory shortages, which are being driven by the rapid growth of artificial intelligence technologies and the significant expansion of data centers that require large amounts of memory.</p> <p>Michael also discussed the process and timelines associated with purchasing and implementing new software systems. He encouraged departments to begin planning summer and fall technology needs now to ensure there is sufficient time to complete the required review, purchasing, and implementation processes before the start of instruction.</p> <p>Angelic added that Purchasing and Information Technology work closely together when departments are acquiring new software or technology systems. She encouraged departments to complete the IT Project Proposal process when considering the purchase of a new system so that IT can evaluate technical requirements, integration needs, and implementation timelines early in the process.</p>
