Minimum Qualifications for Biological Sciences:

Master's in any biological science OR

- This candidate does not list any completed degrees on their application.
- They show proof of more than 12 years of professional experience in the field.
- Does not meet Equivalency.
 They do not show proof of an earned degree that would meet the current standard of an Associate's Degree.

2. Candidate 2

- Does not show proof of an earned degree.
- Notes in equivalency request that they have completed 3 years of a Bachelor's degree.
- Shows evidence of 30 years of relevant experience in graphic and web-based design.
- Transcripts do not show enough coursework to equate to an earned Associate's Degree.
- Does not meet equivalency.

The committee considered the following Equivalencies in Biological Sciences:

Bachelor's in any biological science AND

Master's in biochemistry, biophysics, or marine science OR the equivalent

AND

B. Commitment to the community college goals/objectives of providing quality programs and services for students with diverse abilities and interests; personal qualities to work effectively and sensitively in a multicultural environment; awareness and commitment to the special needs of non-traditional students.

The committee will maintain an ongoing discussion of edits to AP/BP 7211 on Minimum Qualifications and Equivalency until such time as updates are complete.

1. Candidate 1

- Discipline experts have reviewed the application and have determined this candidate is qualified to teach in the discipline. They note that a medical degree requires the requisite biological science courses that meet the standard of "any biological science."
- Holds a PhD in Neuroscience (specific area of study is dental surgery).
- This committee has set the precedent that a PhD in an a pproved area/discipline is "equivalent" to a Master's Degree in said area/discipline.
- Foreign transcript evaluation shows proof of a Bachelor's Degree in Dentistry.
- Meets Equivalency.
