Dejah briefly described the 3 that are available: Profile Analytics; Alumni Outcomes; Go Recruit</li> <li>3-year license for all 3 tools would be approximately \$48,000</li> <li>The LA/OC Regional Consortium may be purchasing the Alumni Outcomes tool for all of the LA colleges, but this has not been decided yet. If the Region does purchase the tool Mt. SAC must share student data to participate. If we purchased the tool ourselves before the Region purchased Alumni Outcomes EMSI is willing to extend our contract.</li> <li>EMSI provided a presentation to the CE Deans on Monday 10/5/20, and they were not in favor of the purchase.
