

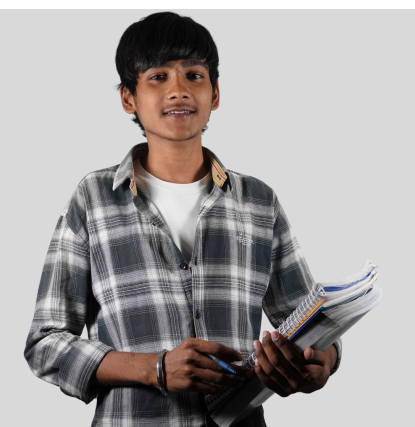

## English Composition (4 units)

- ENGL C1000: Academic Reading & Writing
- AMLA 1A English for non-native speaker
  - Writing will be a fundamental skill that you will use in all college courses. And this course is required for a degree or transfer to a 4-year college.



## Major Course (3-5 units)

- Your college major is your primary area of study—that's the subject you'll receive your degree in.
  - AS/AA/AS-T/AA-T/Certificates: visit **Mt. SAC catalog** [catalog.mtsac.edu/programs/](https://catalog.mtsac.edu/programs/)
  - Transfer UC/CSU: visit **Assist.org**
    - STEM majors must start with science and math courses (e.g., Engineering, Biology, Mathematics, Computer Science, etc.) STEM Math: Math 180 or Math 181 based on assessment placement
