



How is the Registration date/time assigned

Mt. San Antonio College's priority registration was established to help students achieve their educational goals within a reasonable timeframe. Mt. SAC is required by the State of California (Title 5, Section 58108) to establish a system of providing an equal and fair chance for all students to register for the classes they need throughout their college career.

To ensure you get the best possible registration time, it's important to complete the following:

1. Assessment Questionnaire (AQ)
2. Complete online orientation
3. Meet with a counselor

Order of Priority Categories*

1. Military, Foster Youth, ACCESS, EOPS, CalWORKs, Parent of child under 18 years of age
2. Program-based groups (athletics, performance arts, etc.), new matriculants, and non-credit matriculating students
3. Continuing students with fewer than 100 degree-applicable units (in descending order by units earned)
4. New matriculants (if not already in #2)
5. New non-matriculants & returning students with <100 units
6. Students with 100+ degree-applicable units completed
7. K-12 Special Admission students
8. California Virtual Campus (Student-Centered Exchange) students
9. Students not in good academic standing (i.e., on probation, dismissal)
