HOW IS MY REGISTRATION DATE DETERMINED?

Mt. San Antonio College is required by the State of California (Title 5, Section 58108)* to establish a system of providing an equal and fair chance for all students to register for the classes they need throughout their college career.

The College assigns registration priority, in order, to students in the following categories:

- 1 Military Service, Foster Youth, ACCESS, CalWORKs, and EOPS
- 2 Competitive athletic teams, musical performance groups, forensics, dance/cheerleading, other performance groups, Associated Students Government Officers, new students matriculated through Connect 4 program, and matriculating non-credit students all ABE, ESL, and VESL students
- 3 Continuing students who have completed less than 100 degree-applicable units, in descending order from 99.5 units to 0 units, completed at Mt. SAC. Current primary term enrollment, at the time of establishing registration permits, will be counted for the purposes of establishing continuing student eligibility for priority registration for the subsequent term
- 4 New matriculants
- 5 New students who are not matriculants and returning students who have completed less than 100 degree-applicable units, in descending order from 99.5 units to 0 units, completed at Mt. SAC
- 6 Continuing and returning students with 100 or more degree-applicable units completed at Mt. SAC
- 7 K-12 special admission students
- 8 Continuing and returning students not in good academic standing as per Title 5, Section 55031 who have not completed the required counseling intervention
