

Groundskeeper, Athletic Fields

Loyola Marymount University's Facilities Management department has an immediate opening for a Groundskeeper, Athletic Fields. This position is primarily responsible for maintaining five athletic fields by creating safe, high quality playing surfaces for baseball, softball, soccer, and two practices fields. The groundskeeper will prepare fields for both practices and games; provide disease observation and identification; apply fertilizer, pesticides, herbicides, and fungicides with both boom sprayer and spreaders; and operate all necessary equipment pertaining to athletic field maintenance.
