DEFINITION:

Under general supervision, to perform semiskilled and skilled maintenance, repair, and construction tasks pertaining to school facilities, offices and large building; to assist other maintenance personnel in the performance of semiskilled and skilled functions in one or more building and maintenance trade areas; and to do other related work as required.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- 1. Performs semiskilled and skilled tasks of a general nature in maintenance, repair, and construction work in the basic maintenance trades, including carpentry, painting, electrical, plumbing, locksmithing, carpet and tile installation, and metalsmithing.
- 2. Performs a variety of functions in the construction, installation, and maintenance of roofs, furniture, fences, playground equipment, cabinets, shelving, chalkboards, bulletin boards, and a variety of other structures and fixtures.
- 3. Assists in or performs the installation, repair, and maintenance of gas and water lines.
- 4. Installs and replaces door and window glass.
- 5. Makes minor electrical installations and repairs.
- 6. Adjusts, repairs, and maintains electrical equipment and a variety of apparatus and devices.
- 7. Assists in the repair and maintenance of heating, ventilation, and cooling equipment.
- 8. Replaces or repairs carpeting and floor tile.
- 9. May assist in or perform the installation, repair and maintenance of door locks and closures.
- 10. Prepares surfaces, mixes paints and apply finishes to a variety of equipment, furniture, school, and physical structure.
- 11. May weld metal parts together using gas and electric welding process, and fabricates metal and sheet metal structural fixture.
- 12. Operates equipment, such as a light truck, tractors, and other related motorized equipment.

OUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge of:

- 1. Basic methods, techniques, materials, tools, and equipment used in maintenance, repair, and construction functions.
- 2. Rules, regulations and operational procedures pertaining to the repair, maintenance, and construction of school buildings, machines, and equipment.
- 3. Safe working methods and procedures.

Ability to:

1. Skillfully use a variety of tools and equipment utilized in one or more of the basic maintain trades.

Ability to: (continued)

- 2. Work from blueprints, shop drawings, and sketches.
- 3. Maintain simple records and prepare reports.
- 4. Understand and carry out oral and written directions.
- 5. Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships.

EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION:

Any combination of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and skill is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the required knowledge and skill would be:

Experience:

Two years of experience as a semiskilled or skilled worker in one or more of the basic maintenance trades.

Education:

Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade, supplemented by specific training in one or more of the maintenance trades.

License Requirement:

Possession of a valid California Motor Vehicle Operator's License.

Condition of Employment:

- Insurability by the District's liability insurance carrier.
- Must receive asbestos awareness training within the first 60 days of employment.
- May receive additional ACBM training if the employee works in an area in which asbestos building materials may be disturbed.

Benefits: Permanent full-time employees receive \$7,833.10 toward the purchase of medical, dental, and vision coverage. Benefits for permanent part-time employees are prorated according to the number of hours worked per week.
