### I. General Announcements

- Special Guests: Mary Johnson and Sandra Weatherilt joined the department to discuss distance learning.
  - Definition of distance learning is "any seat time replaced." Professors in distance learning need to answer students questions, give feedback, and engagement. Accreditation requires "distance learning" rather than correspondence classes. Distance learning is regular and effective contact/communication with student.
  - Forms requesting distance learning do not ask for determination of online/face-to-face ratio – department/division makes those decisions as long as hours add up. Seat time replacement should be in banner so students are aware.
  - o Campus has policy that if a distance learning class is being offered department should offer class on campus so departments do not becomes exclusively online.
  - There is a different evaluation form needed if distance learning classes are offered. If faculty are up for classroom visitation, the distance learning course must be the one evaluated.
  - Online tools such as "CCC Confer" is one tool that is available for real-time video. CCC
     Confer does offer live captioning.
  - Success rates are about 10% lower for full online and 5% lower for hybrid compared to traditional classes. State is leading an effort to improve student success in online classes.
  - Faculty doing a distance learning class must first do moodle room training and then SPOT certification (http://spot.mtsac.edu)
