Rotation & Seniority	Discussion ensued regarding whether or not to change the rotation established when the economic downturn took place to help guarantee all adjuncts the same minimum number classes per year. Since the economy had picked up, some faculty felt that the Department should go back to a semester rotation based on seniority	Faculty agreed by majority of vote to return to semester rotation on the basis of seniority. The seniority would be also applicable to winter and fall intersessions equally –not independently.

Italian would use the same equivalency as French. Chih-Ping stated that he would provide the Chinese equivalency in the fall (2014).
