Item 1 Approval of minutes from previous meeting

Item 7 Hiring committees

Item 8 **Department Chair Elections**

This topic was postponed.

Item 9 Adjunct Workshop update

A successful Adjunct Workshop was held on Friday 11/13. Seven faculty members attended. The co-chairs thanked the presenters for participating.

Item 10 Spring 2016 Flex Day
