The department was notified that the union is looking into "interest based" bargaining and a handout was distributed about the process.

Elizabeth reported that there were 18 requests made for full time hires using criteria such as replacing the non-tenured who don't receive tenure, course need, GE requirements and fill ratios. Our request to replace Jerry Allen came in fifth place after English, History, History and English.
